Dementia Behaviour Management Advisory Services (DBMAS)

DBMAS is a part of a national network of services which is funded by the Australian Government.

In Tasmania DBMAS is administered by the Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) and managed by Mental Health Services.

DBMAS is offered to those who:

- are in receipt of commonwealth funded care
- have a diagnosis of dementia
- have behaviours of concern which are impacting on care provision

DBMAS is a Statewide Service



DBMAS service provision includes:

- Person centred assessment and support (community and residential)
- Referral and consultation
- Health promotion
- Networking, liaison and collaboration with all stakeholders
- Library (located in Southern office) Books, DVD's and videos
- Sensory Equipment
- Diversional therapy equipment
- Bi-monthly newsletters
- Proactive and reactive education workshops
- Self-Directed Learning Packages
