Completing the statutory declaration forms....

In the statutory declaration form, *ex officio* status means the profession or employment group by virtue of which the person is automatically a Commissioner for Declarations.

Professions whose members are automatically Commissioners for Declarations are:

- Chiropractors
- Dentist
- Legal practitioner
- Medical practitioner
- Nurse
- Patent attorney
- Pharmacist
- Veterinary Surgeon

Employment Groups whose members are automatically Commissioners for Declarations include:

- Clerk of a court
- Commissioner for affidavits
- Credit union officer with 5 or more years of continuous service
- Holder of a statutory office
- Judge of a court
- Magistrate
- Master of a court
- Member of the Parliament of the Commonwealth, a State or Territory or Local government authority
- Minister of Religion
- Permanent employee of the Commonwealth or Commonwealth Authority, of a State or Territory Authority or a local government authority with 5 or more years continuous service
- Police officer
- Registrar or Deputy Registrar of a court
- Senior Executive Service Officer of the Commonwealth or State or Territory or of a Commonwealth, State or Territory Authority
- Teacher employed on a full time basis at a school or tertiary education institution.
