What is communityExpress?

The website 'communityExpress' is an exciting new initiative from the Office for the Community Sector. Consultations with the broad range of community sector organisations and staff highlighted the issue of information overload and the importance of helping people to better organise internet resources.

The 'communityExpress' website will provide:

- A dynamic central hub of information resources for all health and human service providers;
- Quick links to the latest news, updates of current projects and links to other jurisdictions;
- A user friendly entry point to the Department of Health and Human Services internet site with direct links to resources;
- a way to participate in an information exchange with other organisations and individuals; and
- the capacity to add your own links and blogs.

How do I access communityExpress?

How do I subscribe?
