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Application for Authorisation to Obtain, Possess, and Supply Dangerous Poison(s) to which Condition I in Part I of Appendix J of the Uniform Standard Applies (Schedule 7 Appendix J Substances)

Poisons Act 1971

Regulation 91 of the Poisons Regulations 2018

Authorisation Information

Regulation 91 of the Tasmanian *Poisons Regulations 2018* allows the Secretary or delegate to issue an authorisation to obtain, possess, manufacture, sell or supply dangerous poison(s) to which Condition I in Part I of Appendix J of the Uniform Standard applies.

These substances are also known as Schedule 7 substances included in Appendix J of the Commonwealth *Poisons Standard* (the *SUSMP*).

Licensing under the *Poisons Act 1971* and *Poisons Regulations 2018* is not required for users of Schedule 7 substances not included in Appendix J of the *Poisons Standard*.

To obtain authorisation under Regulation 91 this application form must be completed and returned to Pharmaceutical Services Branch. A fee for this authorisation is also payable. If you require an invoice please contact the Branch. Please provide evidence of payment along with your completed application.

Before issuing an authorisation the Department of Health may make any enquiries necessary to establish the bona fides of the applicant and to ascertain if they are a fit and proper person to hold an authorisation.

Authorisations will only be issued for a legitimate use and will not be issued for domestic use.

Authorisations may be issued for a defined period as detailed on the authorisation or may be issued without expiry.

Regulation 91(12) also allows for exceptions to the need for authorisation in specific circumstances in *determined major hazard facilities* as per the *Work Health and Safety Regulations 2012*.

The Tasmanian Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment (DPIPWE) authorise / permit users of certain agricultural Schedule 7 Appendix J substances (e.g. for pest fumigation) under the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1995* and subordinate legislation. Users authorised under this legislation do not require additional licensing under Regulation 91 of the *Poisons Regulations 2018* to possess and use the substance.
