INFORMATION REQUIRED ON A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE FOR A RADIATION PLACE

A certificate of compliance for a radiation place **must** contain at least the following information:

- Address and room number(s) sufficient to uniquely identify the place.
- The date that compliance was determined.
- The name and signature of the holder of the certificate of accreditation under which the certificate of compliance is being issued.
- The title of the Code of Practice the radiation place was tested in accordance with.
- A statement to the effect that the certificate of compliance is being issued in accordance with the requirements of the Tasmanian Radiation Protection Act 2005.
- A certificate of compliance identification number, which must be of the form:

The year (as yyyy), month (as mm) and day (as dd) of the assessment when the radiation place was found to be in compliance with the relevant Code of Practice **followed by a *Radiation Place Identification Number***. For example: 2012 07 31 0251 means that the place with identification number 251 was issued with a certificate of compliance on 31 July 2012.
